

Policy on Collection and Use of Personal Information

l. Policy

All personal information will remain confidential in a secure environment and will be used or disclosed only with consent, except as otherwise stated in the following policy. Personal information includes one's name, electronic mail (e-mail) address and all other data or preferences provided to The Urantia Book Fellowship.

II. Procedure

- A. The following is a list of methods by which individuals will be added to the Fellowship's mailing list:
 - 1. Personal request of reader or acquaintance by visit, phone call, email or letter.
 - 2. Return of the Fellowship mailing list card.
 - 3. Request by reader for study group information.
 - 4. Attendance at Fellowship-sponsored conferences and activities.
 - 5. Subscription to Fellowship-sponsored conferences and activities.
 - 6. Financial contribution to the Fellowship.
 - 7. Becoming a member of a society or member-at-large;
 - 8. Information or list from societies or area contact persons.
 - 9. Lists provided by local conferences (attendee is informed and given the opportunity to decline);
 - 10. Lists provided by other Urantia Book-related organizations (individual is informed and given the opportunity to decline).
 - 11. As a result of product purchases made directly from us or our web store.
- B. The following is a list of methods by which individuals will be removed from the Fellowship's mailing list:
 - 1. Personal request of reader by visit, telephone call, email or letter.
 - 2. Upon request from a society officer.
 - 3. Mail returned with no forwarding address.
 - 4. Upon graduation.

- C. The following is a list of methods by which the Fellowship will use personal information:
 - 1. Personal information is intended exclusively for purposes related to the official business of the organization.
 - 2. To facilitate interaction between The Urantia Book Fellowship, its societies, members, and all others in our database, for general communication, notification of events and fundraising.
 - 3. Personal information will be shared *only* with trusted third parties who assist in operating our website and conducting our business, as long as those parties agree in writing to keep this information confidential.
 - 4. It may be necessary to release information to comply with the law, enforce site policies, or protect individual or organizational rights, property, or safety.
 - 5. The Urantia Book Fellowship will use an individual's personal information as requested by the individual.
