PLAINTIFF DEMANDS TRIAL BY JURY

COMPLAINT AT LAW

Plaintiff, ALYNE C. MEYER, complaining of defendants, CITY OF CHICAGO, a municipal corporation, (hereinafter "CITY OF CHICAGO"); URANTIA BROTHERHOOD CORPORATION, a corporation, (hereinafter "URANTIA BROTHERHOOD"); and THE URANTIA FOUNDATION, a corporation, (hereinafter "URANTIA FOUNDATION"), and each of them, says:

1. On August 20, 1983, defendant, CITY OF CHICAGO, by and through its authorized agents and employees, owned, managed, maintained and controlled certain parkway property, including a sidewalk, on the premises commonly known as 533 West Diversey Parkway, in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.

2. On August 20, 1983, defendants, URANTIA BROTHERHOOD and URANTIA FOUNDATION, and each of them, by and through their authorized agents and employees, owned, managed, maintained and controlled a sidewalk on the premises of 533 West Diversey Parkway, in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.

3. On August 20, 1983, plaintiff, ALYNE C. MEYER, was a pedestrian lawfully upon the aforesaid premises.

4. On August 20, 1983, plaintiff, ALYNE C. MEYER, while walking upon the aforesaid sidewalk, stepped in a hole/defect in the sidewalk and fell.

5. On and before August 20, 1983, defendants, CITY OF CHICAGO, URANTIA BROTHERHOOD and URANTIA FOUNDATION, and each of them, were negligent in one or more of the following respects:

- a. Failed to properly and adequately maintain the sidewalk in a safe condition;
- b. Improperly and inadequately maintained the aforesaid sidewalk;
- c. Failed to repair a hole/defect in the sidewalk;
- d. Improperly and inadequately repaired the hole/defect in the aforesaid sidewalk;
- e. Failed to warn the public that the sidewalk was not in a safe condition.

6. As a proximate result of one or more of the aforesaid, plaintiff, ALYNE C. MEYER, sustained injuries of a personal and pecuniary nature.

7. On November 29, 1983, and within one year of the date of the occurrence herein, plaintiff, ALYNE C. MEYER, caused a notice of intention to bring suit to be served upon defendant, CITY OF CHICAGO. Attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A" is a copy of the Notice.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff, ALYNE C. MEYER, demands judgment against defendants, CITY OF CHICAGO, a municipal corporation; URANTIA BROTHERHOOD CORPORATION, a corporation; and THE URANTIA FOUNDATION, a corporation, and each of them, in a sum in excess of FIFTEEN THOUSAND (\$15,000.00) DOLLARS.
