believe the predominant thinking in the URANTIA Brotherhood is that the small informal URANTIA Book study groups provide the best means of increasing comprehension of the URANTIA teachings.

Regarding the origin and transmission of The URANTIA Book, we can say little here. All available information is provided in the book itself, not as a continuous narrative, but in passages scattered throughout. It therefore requires one or more complete readings to piece together the whole picture.

Certain matters are unknown, having never been revealed. The identity of the human subject through whom the URANTIA Papers came was never disclosed. The Declaration of Trust indicates that plates for printing The URANTIA Book were received by URANTIA Foundation from anonymous contributors upon its formation.

URANTIA Foundation is a non-profit organization. In order to conduct its activities, it relies on both contributions and revenue from sales of The URANTIA Book. Much of the sales revenue received goes toward additional printings of The URANTIA Book.
